



## COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY AND RULES

Following government advice and guidelines from the relevant authorities, Wits End will open for XC schooling from May 20, 2020 by appointment only.

In order to ensure safety at all times we would ask you to arrive knowing things will be very different here at Wits End but this is for everyone's safety.

The following procedures and rules have been put in place:

**DO NOT ATTEND THE SITE IF YOU OR ANY OF THOSE TRAVELLING WITH YOU ARE EXHIBITING ANY SYMPTOMS OF BEING UNWELL OR HAVE BEEN DIRECTED TO SELF-ISOLATE**

- One person from each group must be designated as the person responsible for first aid and will have the necessary PPE with them at all times in case of emergency.
- If the entrance gate is not open when you arrive, please call Jo or Bill at 1-705-435-5353
- Please park your vehicles at least 20 meters from any other vehicles or trailers on the property, or as directed.
- Please send a text message to Charlotte Hodgson upon your arrival and confirm who is in attendance with you if it is different than when you booked.
- Only the dressage ring and cross-country are open for schooling unless we have staff on site to reset show jumps.
- Please only be on site for the time of your appointment.
- Strict timekeeping must be adhered to
- Numbers of people on site will be restricted to 5 in a group including all riders, coach and grooms.
- A portable toilet is available as well as a handwashing station and hand sanitizer. There is also disinfectant available to clean the portable toilet

before or after use. Please clean all surfaces that you have touched after using the toilet.

- You must maintain current social distancing and hygiene practices
- You must follow current government guidelines
- Please bring adequate provisions of food and water for humans and horses none will be available on site
- No spectators are allowed on site, only essential helpers
- Please try to limit touching or sitting on XC fences if you are person on the ground
- You must consider the risk of your activity and ride your horse in the area safe to do so and within your capabilities and fitness levels for you and your horse

Wits End reserves the right to refuse access to the site at any time. They will adhere to Government guideline which can at anytime change - requiring the site to close at short notice should the need require
